# Prayer Center Ministry Outreach

We rely solely on donations of caring individuals. There are a number of ways you can join with St. Francis Prayer Center in helping others and the Prayer Center. Some suggestions:

- Adopt-A-Family for Thanksgiving. Donations help us help more families. \$50 per family of 4.\*

### My Dear Prayer Center Friends,

When Sr. Joanne Chiaverini, IHM, and I started St. Francis Prayer Center in July 1974, General Motors offered 80,000 well-paying jobs and Flint had 200,000 people. Today there are 7,500 GM jobs and Flint has 98,000 people. This has led to many desperate needs such as:

- 40% of residential properties are abandoned
- Median income is \$24,834.00 in Flint and \$48,411.00 statewide
- 62% of Flint's children live in poverty compared with 24% statewide
- 41% of residents live in poverty compared with 17% statewide

Many blue collar workers and professionals who have supported St. Francis Prayer Center over all the years are much fewer. When we beg (or solicit funds) for support, we have the feeling of the early disciples of Jesus as they took the "five loaves and two fish" to Jesus to try to feed the huge, hungry crowd.

"What are these among so many?" they asked. Today we ask that question of our resources, "What are these among so many?"

Debra Hawley, our director, works so hard to help meet the needs of countless people who seek assistance and she has multiplied retreat and prayer experiences in remarkable ways, both at the Center and in parishes. But the funds come in too slowly. That is where we rely on you. As a Board member now, I still see the great good we are doing but we really need your help!
